

Tips For Kids




The Tips for Kids program is a fun-filled volunteer component of Roof Sit. Volunteer groups pump gas and wash windows for tips at participating local Shell and Bob and Kay gas stations.


Groups sign-up for two-hour or four-hour volunteer shifts at a station of their choice. Supervisors are on hand to provide assistance and guidance. At the end of the shift, the groups bring the money (tips) they collected to the Roof Sit headquarters at Helzberg Diamonds and Hairmasters on Westnedge Ave. in Portage.

Tips for Kids is held during the week of Roof Sit, May 14-17. 103.3 KFR helps to promote the groups that volunteer.





When and where does Roof Sit 2008 take place?

 Roof Sit is a 4 day fundraising event held May 14-17, 2008.

 Roof Sit Headquarters is located on Westnedge Ave. on the roof of the Helzberg Diamonds and HairMasters building.


What happens during the event?


 During Roof Sit, 103.3 KFR Morning Show disc jockies sit on a roof for three nights and four days to raise money and awareness about treatment and prevention of child abuse and neglect.


 103.3 KFR and WWMT News Channel 3 promote the event with live interviews and personal stories.
